The year 2015-2016 has been a turning point for the Foundation and the Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent.



>> SPECIAL ANNIVERSARIES

First and foremost, two anniversaries must be honoured; 40 years of existence for the Marie-Vincent Foundation and 10 years of existence for the Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent. Founded in 1975, the Marie-Vincent Foundation helped children aged 5 to 12 years with important socio-affective problems. The Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent offered schooling and psychology services. In 1994, the Foundation redefined its mission in order to reach all kids aged 12 and under that were victims of all forms of mistreatment.

In 2005, the Marie-Vincent Foundation contributed to the creation of the Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent, which offers services to children victim of sexual abused, to children with sexual behaviour problems, and also to their parents. In line with these services, and with the intent of offering state-of-the-art knowledge

based on the best practices, the Foundation supports the Marie-Vincent Interuniversity Chair. The Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent also distinguished itself by an innovative concept that places the child at the forefront of its preoccupations, in bringing a multidisciplinary team that offers police force, medical, psychosocial and socio judiciary services, all under the same roof.

>> PURSUING A DREAM

It's in focusing on the combined forces of the Foundation, the Centre d'expertise Marie-Vincent and the Interuniversity Research Chair that the future of the Marie-Vincent Foundation takes a most dynamic momentum with a new organizational structure put in place. It brings focus on the integration of philanthropic activities, communication, public awareness and decision makers to its cause, but also to the high level of expertise at the client services level.

So here are mentioned only a few of the elements that will change the focus of our next year and shape our dream.

>> FUTURE PROJECTS

BEATRICE'S STORY

>>> Béatrice is 8 years old.

At the age of 6, Simon, a good friend of her parents who babysat on a regular basis, gave her massages to make her fall asleep. Gradually, these massages transformed into sexual assaults.

At first, Beatrice didn't understand what was happening. Growing up, she understood that this was not right. She felt guilty and did not dare to speak to her parents about it. Her parents never imagined that their friend could have touched their little girl. Simon was nowhere near what they imagined a sexual abuser looked like.

Gradually, the behaviour of Beatrice started to change. At home, she had nightmares. At school, she isolated herself and didn't want to go to her dance classes anymore.

Her mother, worried about seeing her daughter, who was so happy and joyful before, become more withdrawn, smile less, decided to get help. That is how Béatrice finally told what had happened to her and was able to start a specialized therapy for children having been sexually abused at the Marie-Vincent Foundation.


Today, thanks to the services received at the Marie-Vincent Foundation, Beatrice is much better. She is able to tell her story but most of all, she knows that what happened is not her fault.

The nightmares have stopped, she now plays with her friends and she goes to her dance classes. Béatrice regained her smile, her joyfulness and her childhood vulnerability! Following the treatment offered at Marie-Vincent, studies have demonstrated that the children show:

- a better self-esteem:
- less anxiety symptoms;
- less depression symptoms;
- · less avoidance strategies;
- less post-traumatic stress symptoms;
- · less guilty feelings;
- less disassociation symptoms.




